The Delaware County Board of Supervisors is now accepting applications for four (4) new Lake Delhi Combined Recreational Facility and Water Quality District Trustees. Senate File 412, signed by Governor Branstad earlier this month, increased the number of trustees under Iowa Code Section 357E from three (3) to seven (7) with the additional four (4) members being initially appointed by the Board of Supervisors. The four (4) new positions will have terms effect on July 1, 2011 with one being appointed for a one year term, one for a two (2) year term, and two (2) for three (3) year terms. After the initial appointment expires, the position will be filled at the regularly scheduled district election. Applications can be picked up at the Delaware County Auditor's Office, the Delaware County Supervisor's Office or online at www.co.delaware.ia.us. Please return all completed applications to the Delaware County Auditor's Office. The deadline for applying is June 17, 2011.
