

ATV/SNOWMOBILE RENEWALS ARE DUE

BRING IN MOST CURRENT REGISTRATION

Deb Peyton, Delaware County Recorder, wants to remind the residents of Delaware County that the 2010 registration renewal period for snowmobiles and all-terrain vehicles (ATV's) will run from now until December 31, 2009.

Registration renewals have typically been completed by the County Recorder's office. While the Recorders will still be providing this service, owners may now renew registrations at any ELSI vendor that sells Iowa hunting and fishing licenses. You must present your most recent registration for each vehicle to complete the process. However, when individuals seeking to register a new ATV or snowmobile or transfer ownership of a vehicle into their name, they must still initiate that transaction at their local County Recorder's office.

Snowmobile and ATV owners must renew their registrations by December 31, 2009 to avoid a \$5.00 penalty. Registering early will help avoid dealing with long lines. Mailed renewals must be postmarked no later than December 31, 2009 to avoid the same \$5.00 penalty.

Owners of off-road utility vehicles (ORV's) should be aware that their 2009 registrations expire on December 31, 2009. Individuals may purchase 2010 ORV registrations beginning December 15, 2009. ORV's must be registered if they will be used for ice fishing or other approved uses on public grounds.

Office hours thru the month of December will be 8:00 – 4:30, Monday thru Friday. The office will be closed December 24th and December 25th for the Christmas holiday and January 1st for the New Year's holiday. The office will also close at 3:00 P.M. on December 31st to close out the year end books.
